GATHERING IN CHURCH FOR MASS As the COVID restrictions begin to ease we are now

able to gather again in church for Mass.

As before, there are certain conditions in place: • MAXIMUM of 50 people

- Social distancing
- Follow the direction of the Stewards
- Follow the direction of the Steward
 Sanitising hands on entry and exit
- Sanitising narius on entry and exit
 Wearing mask covering nose & mouth while inside
- Church doors will also need to be left open to provide the necessary ventilation

Up to 50 people can now attend funerals and wedding services in church. However, the government are advising that other religious ceremonies, especially those that could involve gatherings before/afterwards like Communions and Confirmations, do <u>not</u> take place at this time. The resumption of Baptism ceremonies remains on hold, still under ongoing diocesan review.
